Frequently Asked Questions

ANZAC day falls on a Sunday in 2021, does that mean that the public holiday is observed on the Monday?

Victoria, New South Wales, and Tasmania

In these states there is no substitute day for ANZAC day. It is observed only on the Sunday.

Australian Capital Territory, Northern Territory, Queensland, South Australia, and Western Australia

In these states because ANZAC days falls on a Sunday, there is a substitute holiday on Monday 26th April.

What happens if we have an employee who lives in another state, which public holidays should be recognized?

The employee should follow the same public holidays in which the business follows, based on which state the business is based. It is best practise when employing employees to be explicit about this to avoid any ambiguity.
